

Clementine the Bunny Amigurumi

A soft, long-eared amigurumi bunny with rosy cheeks and a tiny cotton-tail pom pom. Worked in continuous rounds with basic single crochet — an easy weekend project.

CRAFT Crochet (amigurumi)	SKILL LEVEL Easy / Confident beginner	SIZE Approx. 9" (23cm) tall, ears up
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MATERIALS

Worsted weight (Aran) yarn: Cream/white (main), Pink (ear lining, cheeks, nose) — approx. 100g cream, 15g pink. Small amount of white boucle or fluffy yarn for the tail (optional).

3.5mm (US E/4) crochet hook, or size needed for a firm, tight fabric.

Polyester fiberfill stuffing.

2 x 10mm safety eyes (or embroider eyes for very young children).

Stitch marker, yarn needle, pink embroidery thread for nose/whisker dots.

GAUGE

Gauge isn't critical, but work more tightly than usual so stuffing doesn't show through the fabric. Aim for approx. 18 sts and 20 rounds = 4" (10cm) in single crochet.

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = Chain

Rep = Repeat

Sc = Single crochet

Inc = 2 sc in same st

Dec = Sc2tog (invisible dec)

Sl st = Slip stitch

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

BLO = Back loop only

MR = Magic ring

Worked in continuous rounds (spiral) unless stated otherwise — do not join or turn. Use a stitch marker to track the beginning of each round, moving it up each time.

HEAD (make 1, cream)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR. (6)

Rnd 2: Inc in each st around. (12)

Rnd 3: *Sc 1, inc; rep from * around. (18)

Rnd 4: *Sc 2, inc; rep from * around. (24)

Rnd 5: *Sc 3, inc; rep from * around. (30)

Rnd 6: *Sc 4, inc; rep from * around. (36)

Rnds 7–13: Sc around, even. (36) — place safety eyes between rnds 8 and 9, approx. 10 sts apart, before continuing.

Rnd 14: *Sc 4, dec; rep from * around. (30)

Rnd 15: *Sc 3, dec; rep from * around. (24)

Rnd 16: *Sc 2, dec; rep from * around. (18) Begin stuffing firmly and continue to stuff as you close.

Rnd 17: *Sc 1, dec; rep from * around. (12)

Rnd 18: Dec around. (6)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Weave tail through front loops of last 6 sts, pull closed, secure.

With pink embroidery thread, add a small nose stitch and 2–3 whisker dots on each cheek at the front of the face, around rnd 10.

EARS (make 2, cream with pink lining)

Starting with pink, ch 8.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, 3 sc in last ch, continue along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each ch across. (16)

Rnd 2: Inc in next 3 sts, sc around to last 3 sts, inc in each of last 3 sts. (22)

Change to cream.

Rnds 3–6: Sc around, even. (22)

Rnd 7: Dec twice, sc to end. (20)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Flatten and sew the base of each ear to the top of the head, angled slightly outward, with the pink lining facing forward.

CHEEKS (make 2, pink, optional)

Rnd 1: 5 sc in MR. (5) Fasten off, leaving a tail. Sew one to each cheek just below and outside the eyes for extra dimension — or embroider flat circles instead if you prefer.

BODY (make 1, cream)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR. (6)

Rnd 2: Inc in each st around. (12)

Rnd 3: *Sc 1, inc; rep from * around. (18)

Rnd 4: *Sc 2, inc; rep from * around. (24)

Rnd 5: *Sc 3, inc; rep from * around. (30)

Rnds 6–14: Sc around, even. (30) — work a soft pink oval patch down the front of the body across rnds 8–12 by changing colour or embroidering afterwards, for the belly marking.

Rnd 15: *Sc 3, dec; rep from * around. (24) Begin stuffing firmly.

Rnd 16: *Sc 2, dec; rep from * around. (18)

Rnd 17: *Sc 1, dec; rep from * around. (12) Finish stuffing.

Rnd 18: Dec around. (6)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Close as for Head.

ARMS (make 2, cream)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR. (6)

Rnds 2–9: Sc around, even. (6)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff lightly, leaving the last round unstuffed and flattened for sewing.

LEGS (make 2, cream, with a pink foot pad)

With pink: **Rnd 1:** 6 sc in MR. (6)

Rnd 2: Inc in each st around. (12)

Rnd 3: Sc around, even. (12)

Change to cream.

Rnds 4–12: Sc around, even. (12)

Rnd 13: Dec 3 times evenly, sc to end. (9)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff each leg firmly, leaving the last 2 rounds unstuffed and flattened for sewing to the body.

TAIL (make 1, white boucle or cream)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR. (6)

Rnd 2: Inc in each st around. (12)

Rnds 3–5: Sc around, even. (12)

Rnd 6: Dec around. (6)

Fasten off, leaving a tail. Stuff firmly to make a small round pom — for extra fluff, add a few loose loops of yarn or a small pom pom made separately and sewn on top.

ASSEMBLY

1. If not already added, embroider the nose and whisker dots onto the face, and sew the cheek circles in place just below the eyes.
2. Sew both ears to the top of the head, angled slightly outward so they stand up.
3. Sew the head to the top of the body, keeping the face centred over the belly patch.
4. Sew the arms to the upper sides of the body, just below the head.
5. Sew the legs to the base of the body, angled slightly forward, so the bunny can sit or stand.
6. Sew the tail to the back of the body, just above the legs.
7. Weave in all remaining ends.

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
